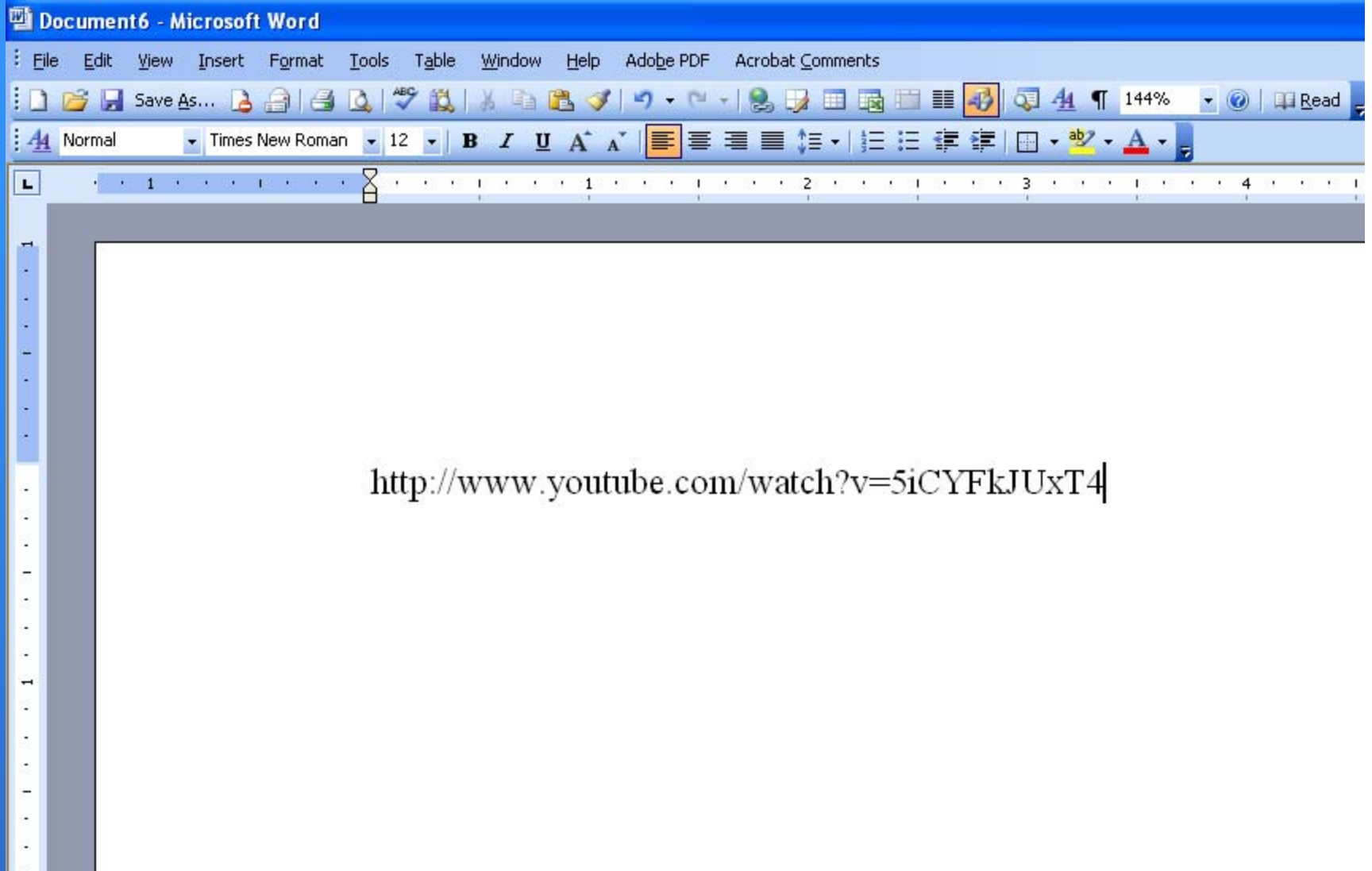

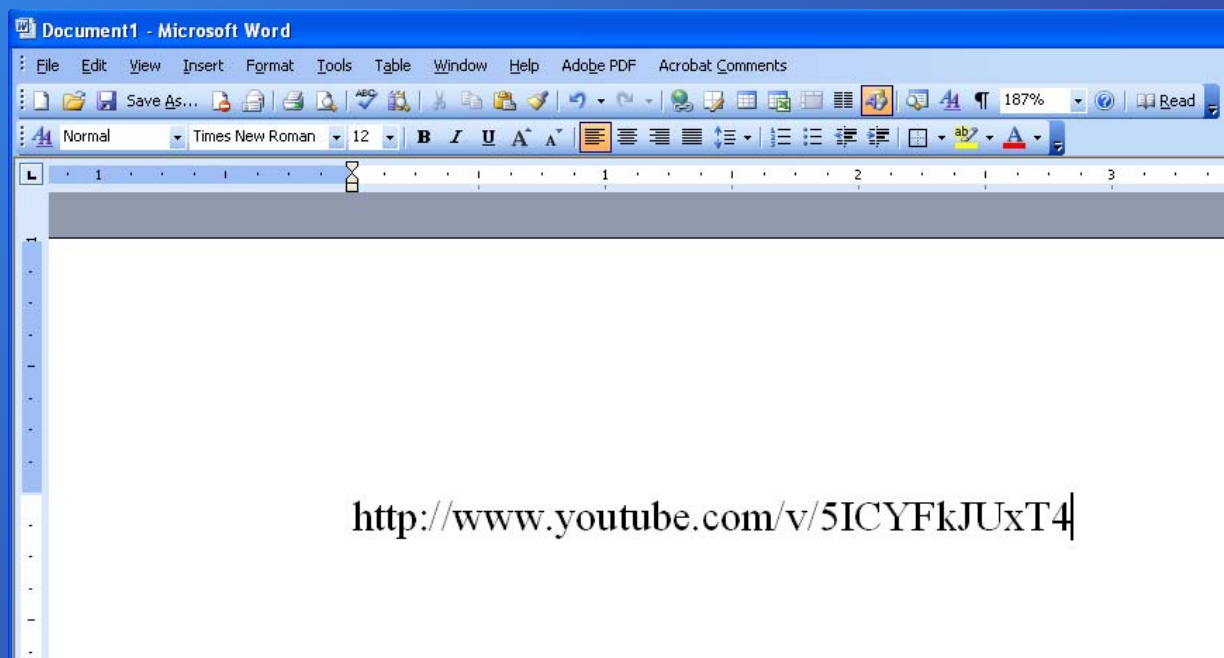

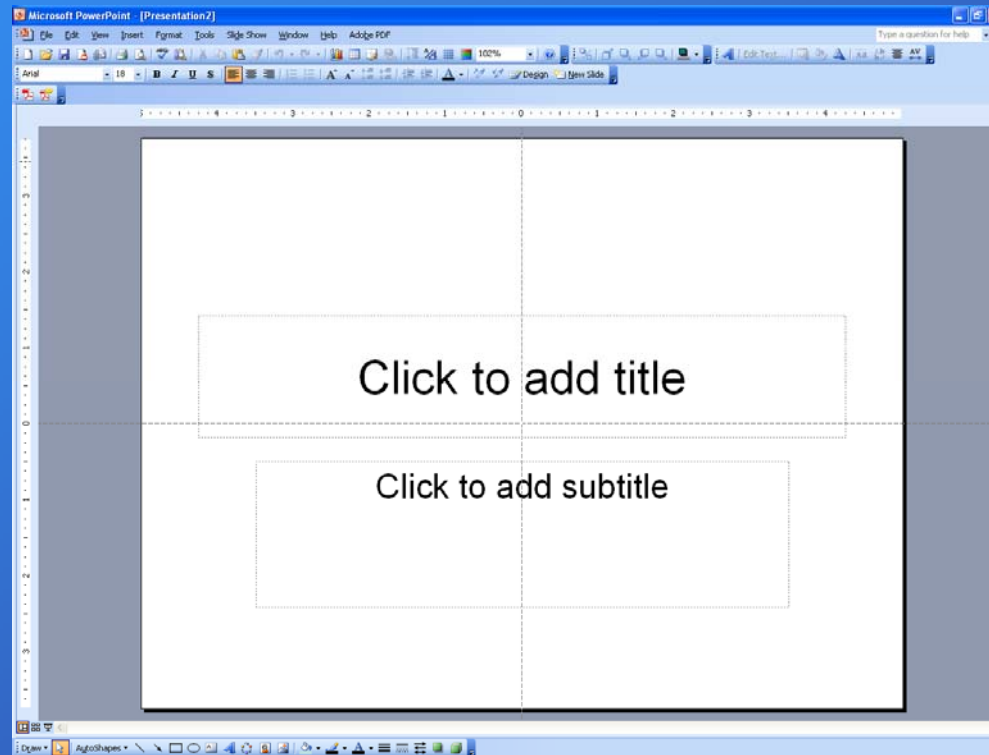


- Delete the text “watch?”

- Copy that text.

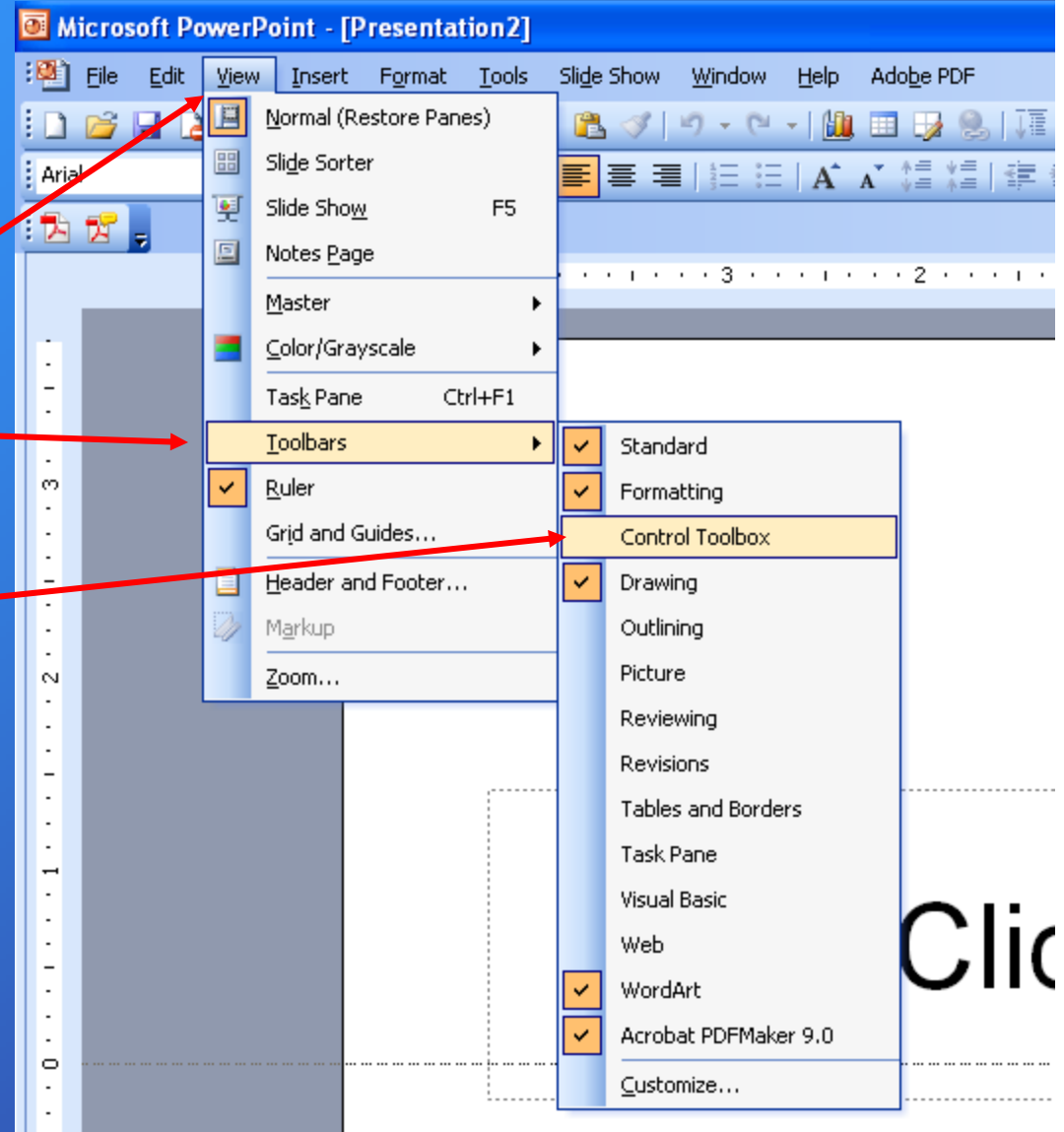


Open PowerPoint

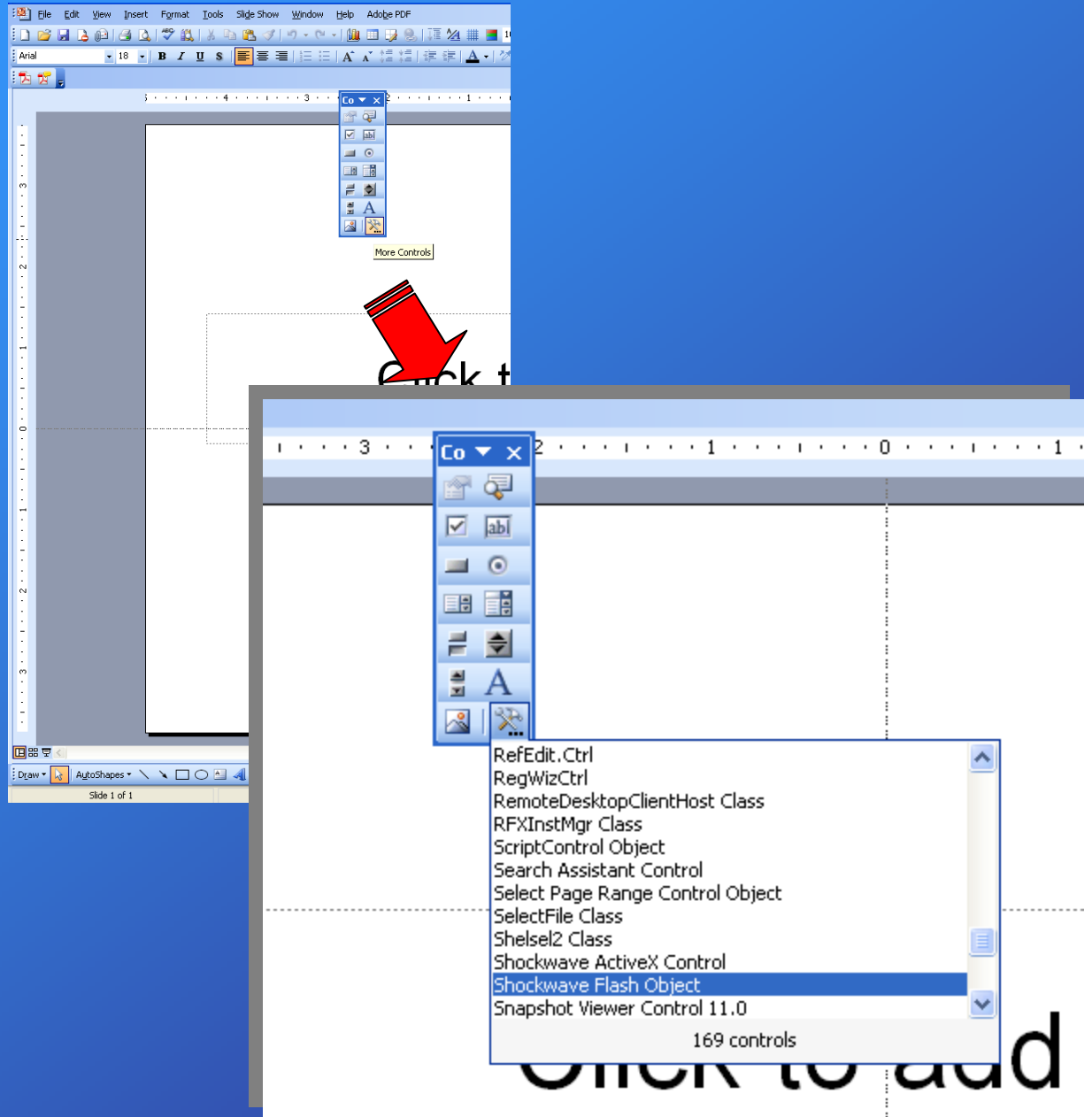
- Go to a blank slide or where you want the video inserted.



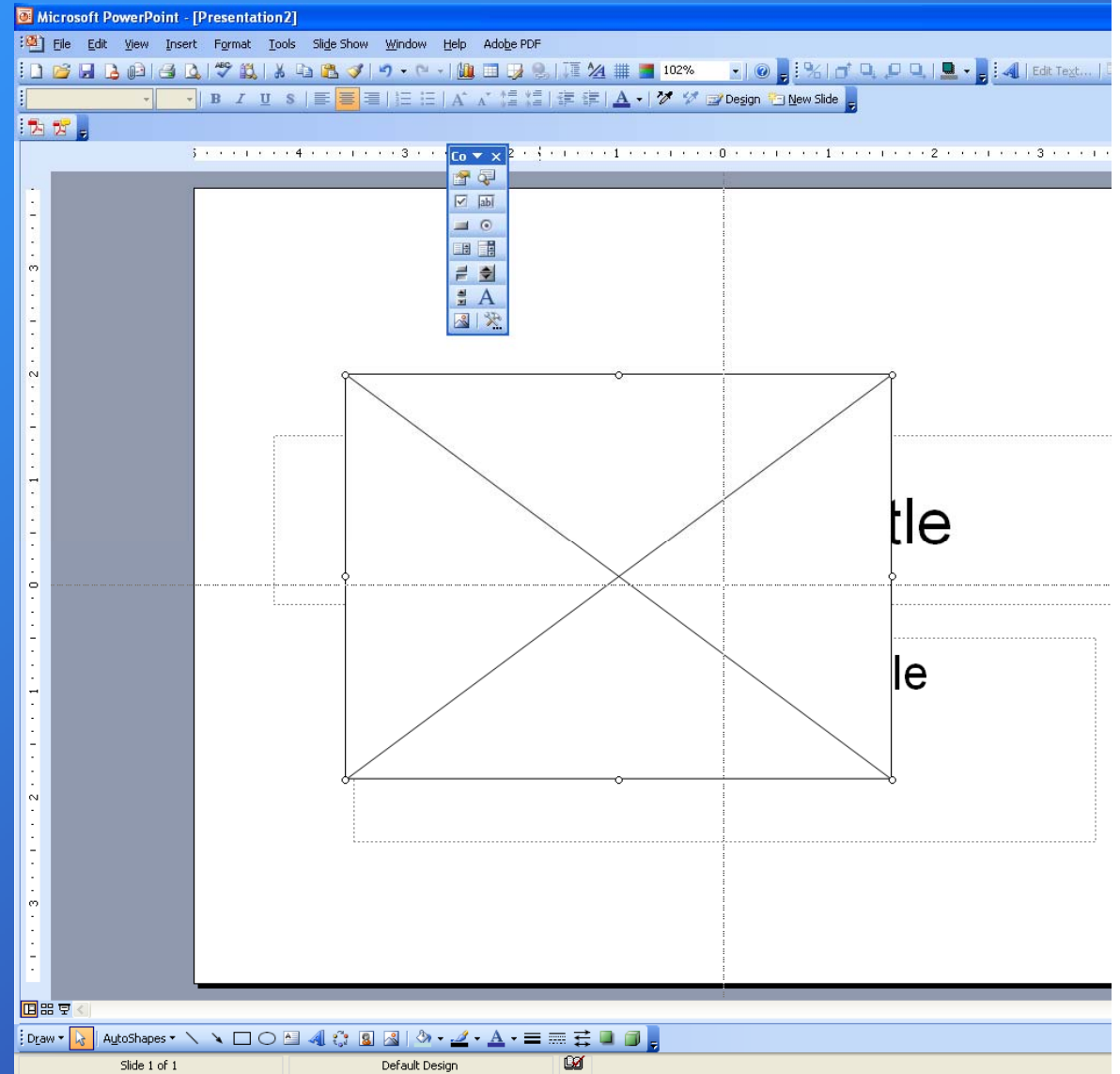
- Click on View, Toolbars, then Control Toolbox



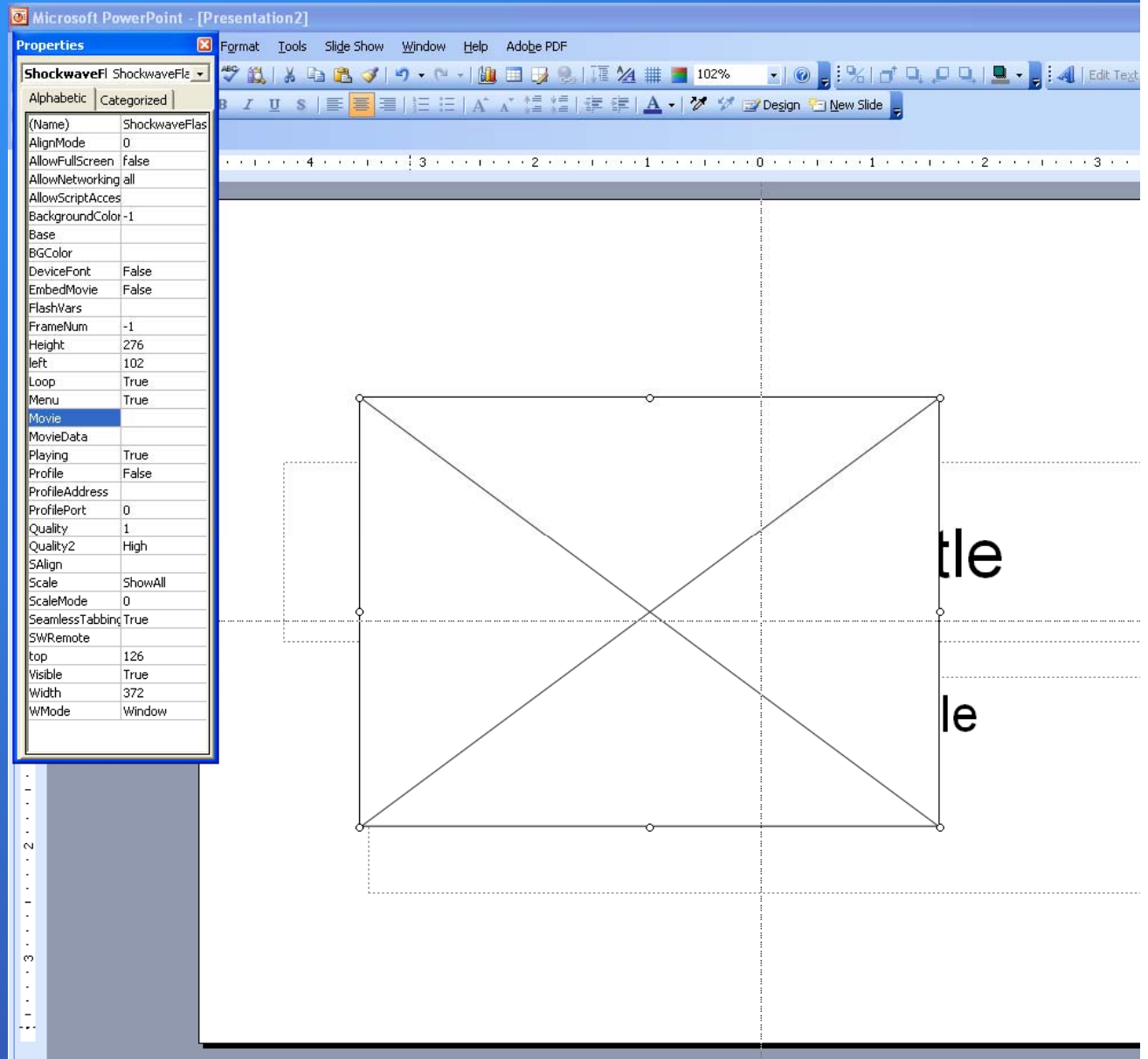
- Click on More Controls, then scroll down & select Shockwave Flash Object.



- Now draw the box for your video.
- Close the Controls box.



- Right-click on the box you just drew and select **Properties**.
- Select the value entitled **Movie**.



- Paste in the movie link from the Word document.
