Application Requirements:

1. Completion of an undergraduate degree program and at least **82 SHs in Art**.
2. A minimum **3.0** cumulative average.
3. Completion of **Graduate Record Exam or Miller's Analogy Test**.
4. Forwarding to the Graduate Art Coordinator (Prof. Mary-Ellen Campbell) the following materials:
 - a. Professional **resume**.
 - b. **Transcripts** of previous college work.
 - c. **Two letters of recommendation** sent directly to the coordinator from those making the recommendations.
 - d. A **2 page statement of purpose** relative to interest and planned study. This will serve as a writing sample and may show need for remedial English courses.
 - e. **Slides, portfolio, film, CD or video** as applicable, representing artistic accomplishment.
5. Students for whom English is a second language must arrange for TOEFL testing and ESL course placement through the graduate office and must continue their ESL studies throughout their graduate program.

Deadlines: Applications should be in by **Nov. 1** for the Spring semester and **April 1** for the following Fall semester.

Application materials will be reviewed by a faculty committee consisting of the graduate art coordinator and art faculty representing the selected specialization courses.
