


Overall Fall 2020 Down; Fitch and Moody's Negative Outlook for Higher Education






Undergraduates In NJ Declined By 32,290 While Graduate Students Declined By 1,008 Between 2009-2019




The Top 20 Institutions In Total Number of Full/Part Time Undergraduate & Graduate Students, 2019




NJ Population Projections by County, 2010-2030

• Monmouth (#5) and Ocean (#6) are among the top counties with the largest projected population growth.




NJCU @ Brookdale/Wall Moves 11 Miles North to NJCU @ Fort Monmouth





Fort Monmouth, located in Monmouth County is the 1,126-acre former U.S. Army base decommissioned in 2011.






