

NJCU / g-MEO Study Abroad Application Checklist

To Study Abroad, NJCU students must have a 2.5 GPA and have completed 30 credits successfully with at least one semester completed at NJCU. You must complete both the g-MEO and NJCU applications by November 1, 2015 to be eligible to study abroad. (FALL DEADLINE?)

Select the courses you wish to enroll during your semester abroad - choose 5 courses you wish to enroll in and an additional 3 courses as back up in case any of your top choices are cancelled for low enrollment
Medical Report	approval from your Academic Advisor for the courses you have selected
Financial Aid Worksheet** (if applying for financial aid)	Scan a copy of the information page of your passport to Ms. Wen Wang at wen.wang@g-meo.com. If you do not have a passport, or if your passport will expire within a year, please apply for a new passport or renewal IMMEDIATELY.
