

 **APA Style Reference List Guide****Book****Format:**

Author's last name, first and second initial. (Year). *Title of book*. Publication location: Publishing Company.

Example:

Townsend, R. M. (1993). *The medieval village economy*. Princeton: Princeton University Press.

Entry in an Encyclopedia**Format:**

Author's last name, first and second initial. (Year). Title of the entry. In *Title of the encyclopedia* (Vol. number, page number). Publication location: Publisher.

Example:

Bergmann, P. G. (1993). Relativity. In *The new encyclopaedia Britannica* (Vol. 26, pp. 501-508). Chicago: Encyclopedia Britannica.

Note:

If an entry has no author, place the title of the entry in the author position.

Example:

Imago. (2000). In *World book encyclopedia* (Vol. 10, p. 79). Chicago: World Book Encyclopedia.

Journal Article (print)**Format:**

Author's last name, first and second Initial. (Year). Article title. *Journal title, volume number*(issue number), page numbers.

Example:

Martinez-Pons, M. (2002). Parental influences on children's academic self-regulatory development. *Theory Into Practice, 41*(2), 126-132.

Note:

To cite an article in a weekly magazine, give the complete date, e.g. (1999, June 6)

Journal article (retrieved from library database)**Format 1: Article is assigned a DOI (Digital Object Identifier)**

Author's last name, first and second Initial. (Year). Article title. *Journal title, volume number*(issue number), page numbers. doi: xxxxxxxxx

Example:

Meyer, U., & Feldon, J. (2009). Neural basis of psychosis-related behaviour in the infection model of schizophrenia. *Behavioural Brain Research, 204*(2), 322-334.
doi:10.1016/j.bbr.2008.12.022

Format 2: Article is NOT assigned a DOI

Author's last name, first and second Initial. (Year). Article title. *Journal title, volume number*(issue number), page numbers. Retrieved from database home page URL

Example:

Esper, P. (2009). Immune Modulation in Melanoma and Advanced Cancer Therapy. *Clinical Journal of Oncology Nursing, 13*(5), 547-554. Retrieved from <http://search.ebscohost.com>

Web Site**Format:**

Author if given, (date of web site if given; use n.d. if no date). *Title of web site*. Retrieved date from URL (no period used after URL)

Example 1:

Grohol, J.M. (2003). *Dr. John Grohol's PsychCentral*. Retrieved March 13, 2003, from <http://psychcentral.com>

Example 2:

Thompson, G. (n.d.). *Youth coach handbook*. Retrieved September 17, 2001, from <http://www.joesoccer.com/menu.html>
