TYPES of ACTION PLANS

ASSESSMENT METHODS/ INSTRUMENTS

Revise: test, rubric, survey

Increase target

Establish reliability of instrument

Workshop on Measures: April 11, 10 – 11:30 AM

TYPES of ACTION PLANS

Curriculum

Emphasis of outcomes (I, R, M) across program

Add/ delete/revise: assignments, course

Pre-requisites, elective>>>required

Workshop on Outcomes: March 20, 10 – 11:30 AM

Student support and enrichment

Tutoring, library

Co-curricular opportunities

TYPES of ACTION PLANS

Pedagogy

Faculty development, collaboration
Study teams for instructional methods

Using Assessment Results:

Closing the Loop with Action Plans

COMMON CHALLENGES to ACTION PLANS

- •Course vs. Program focus (collaboration)
- •Misalignment of outcomes and measures
- Measures too broad
- •Targets too cautious /conservative
- •Reluctance to accept change
- •The perfect being the enemy of the good

Closing the Loop with Action Plans

DEVELOPING ACTION PLANS

- 1. ANALYZE ASSESSMENT DATA
 - ✓ Summaries, patterns
 - ✓ Review benchmarks and target
- 2. Develop hypotheses for results
- 3. Explore possibilities to address hypotheses
- 4. Select and implement
