Student Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the Educational Leadership MA program:

1. Our graduates have the professional knowledge and decision-making skills to satisfy ISLLC standards I, II, III, IV, and VI.
2. Our graduates are caring educational leaders.

Claims are based on the ISLLC standards and the New Jersey Administrative Code (NJAC 6A:9 – 3.4) Professional Standards for School Leaders (NJPSSL) that describe educational leaders as persons who have the knowledge and ability to:

- I. Promote the success of all students facilitating the development, articulation, implementation, and stewardship of a vision of learning that is shared and supported by the school community;
- II. Advocating, nurturing, and sustaining a school culture and instructional program conducive to student learning and staff professional growth;
- III. Ensuring management of the organization, operations, and resources for a safe, efficient, and effective learning environment;
- IV. Collaborating with families and community members, responding to diverse community interests and needs, and mobilizing community resources;
- V. Acting with integrity, fairness, and in an ethical manner;
- VI. Understanding, responding to, and influencing the larger political, social, economic, legal, and cultural context.
