



NJCU 2010 Summer Session Tuition Deferment Contract

Terms and Conditions of the NJCU 2010 Summer Session

In order to participate in the **NJCU 2010 Summer Session Tuition Deferment Plan** you must submit an application certifying that you are eligible and agree to the terms of the plan as outlined. The **2010 Summer Session Deferment Plan** is an option provided by the University to assist students who are motivated to continue their studies but face economic challenges in paying the tuition by the payment deadline.

Please understand that this deferment:

- only postpones the payment of your tuition and fees until **October 1, 2010**;
 - does not guarantee that your summer or future financial aid will cover those fees;
 - does not cover the purchase of books, a parking permit, and other such costs.
1. NJCU provides the option of a delayed payment plan for the 2010 Summer Session enrollment period until October 1, 2010. Also, provides the option of utilizing excess financial aid for Fall 2010 to cover Summer 2010 tuition and fees. The plan can be used only for tuition and fee costs and will not be processed until the student is registered.
 2. The plan is made available only to continuing undergraduate and graduate NJCU students, who have completed at least two consecutive semesters of enrollment at the University, have a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA (undergraduate) or 3.0 cumulative GPA (graduate), and **do not have an outstanding balance due on their account.**
 3. This plan is not available to visiting students or students already receiving a tuition waiver.
 4. An application must be submitted for each term of enrollment by the established payment deadline dates of May 13th for Summer Session I and June 24th for Summer Session II.
 5. By completing an application, the student agrees to pay NJCU the full tuition fees incurred by **October 1, 2010.**
 6. The student permits NJCU to utilize Fall 2010 excess financial aid to cover the full tuition and fees for Summer 2010.
 7. Any balance incurred due to financial aid adjustment has to be paid by October 1st, 2010.
 8. **Payments received past the due date will be assessed a \$50.00 late payment fee.**
 9. If a student withdraws from any classes, payment becomes due and payable immediately.
 10. A \$100.00 tuition deposit is required at the time of submitting the application.
 11. Must apply for Summer 2010 Financial aid (which requires a 2009-2010 FAFSA) and 2010-11 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) (undergraduate students only).
 12. **Please be aware that the deadline to apply for summer aid is May 3rd for Summer I and June 10th for Summer II.**
 13. If the student has a past due balance from a prior term, the student will not be eligible to use the 2010 Summer Session Tuition Deferment Plan until the repayment of the past due balance.
 14. Any student that has defaulted on a prior year summer deferment will not be eligible to utilize this deferment arrangement again.

The following guidelines apply to my participation in the **NJCU 2010 Summer Session Tuition Deferment Plan**:

- I understand that to participate in the deferment program, I must be a continuing undergraduate or graduate NJCU student, who has completed at least one semester (including Spring 2010) of enrollment at the University at the time of this application, do not have an outstanding balance due on my student financial account and have a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA (undergraduate) or 3.0 cumulative GPA (graduate).
- I understand that I must be registered for the Fall 2010.
- By completing an application, I agree to pay NJCU the full tuition and fee amount incurred by **October 1, 2010**. **Payments received past the due date will be assessed a \$50.00 late payment fee.**
- Any student that has defaulted on a prior year summer deferment will not be eligible to utilize this deferment arrangement again.
- If I withdraw from a class (or classes), payment becomes due and payable immediately.
- I agree to pay \$100.00 tuition deposit at the time of submitting the application (will be applied towards tuition). If a student chooses to register for each summer session separately, then a \$100 tuition deposit is due with each separate application.
- I understand that I must apply for summer 2010 financial aid (which requires a 2009-2010 FAFSA), and that program (i.e. Federal Stafford Loans, grants, scholarships, etc...), proceeds received will first be used as immediate payment (s) to the amount owed for the current term. (undergraduate students only)
- I completed the 2010-11 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) (Undergraduate students only)
- I agree to permit NJCU to utilize Fall 2010 financial aid disbursements (i.e. Federal Stafford Loans, grants, scholarships, etc...) to pay 2010 Summer session tuition and fees.
- I acknowledge and understand that if for any reason my anticipated aid/loans are not disbursed or are not sufficient to cover both terms; I will be responsible to pay the outstanding balance by **October 1st 2010**.
- I understand that this application will be denied if I have a past due balance from a prior term.**
