**IMPORTANT:** Federal TEACH Grants will be awarded to eligible students for the 2022-2023 academic year. Eligibility and award is based on term enrollment. Students will be reviewed every term to ensure GPA and program eligibility. This form must be received in the Office of Financial Aid at least 30 days prior to your last date of enrollment during the 2022-2023 academic year.

**DIRECTIONS:** Complete this form to be considered for the federal Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant program. The TEACH Grant provides **up to** \$4,000 per year (subject to funding approval by the U.S. Department of Education) (\$16,000 total for 4-year undergraduate programs and \$8,000 total for graduate programs) in grants to students who commit to:

- 1. Teach full-time
- 2. Teach in high-need subject areas
- 3. Teach for at least four out of the first eight years after completing the teaching degree
- 4. Teach at schools that serve students from low-income families.
- 5. Be enrolled in one of the following TEACH Grant approved programs at:
  - <u>UNDERGRAD</u>: Early Childhood Education with Dual Certification in P-3 and TOSD BA; Elementary Education (K-6) and Teacher of Students with Disabilities (TOSD) BA; Middle School Subject (6-8) Mathematics Endorsement (NOTE: Must be tied to degree program); Middle School Subject (6-8) Science Endorsement (NOTE: Must be tied to degree program) Middle School Subject (6-8) Spanish Endorsement (NOTE: Must be tied to degree program); Secondary Education (K-12): Biological Science BA; Secondary Education (K-12): Chemistry BA; Secondary Education (K-12): Physics BA; Secondary Education (K-12): Spanish BA
  - **GRAD:** Early Childhood Education and Special Education MAT; Reading Specialist MA; Secondary Education (K-12): Biological Science MAT; Secondary Education (K-12): Chemistry MAT; Secondary Education (K-12): Earth Science MAT; Secondary Education (K-12): Mathematics MAT; Secondary Education (K-12): Physics MAT; Secondary Education (K-12): Spanish MAT; Special Education MA; Special Education MAT; Urban Education: Bilingual Education MA; Urban Education: English as a Second Language MA
