Exams available:

Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI) - \$165.00: measures your ability to speak in a language. It is a live, unscripted, 15–30-minute phone conversation with a Certified ACTFL Tester. It must be scheduled in advance by selecting possible dates and times during the ordering process.

Oral Proficiency Interview by computer (OPIc) – \$108.00: measures your ability to speak in a language. It is a 20–40-minute virtual conversation conducted online. An avatar will present you with prompts based on your interests and experiences and that are designed to identify your specific proficiency level.

Writing Proficiency Test (WPT) - \$108.00: is an Internet-Based test that measures your writing ability in a particular language. The test consists of two to five writing tasks. It is taken online and lasts approximately 20-80 minutes.

<u>Listening Proficiency Test (LPT) - \$51.00:</u> is an *on-demand* test that measures your listening comprehension in a particular language. Candidates listen to a number of passages and answer related multiple choice questions. It is a *50-125 minutes* test taken *online*.

Reading Proficiency Test (RPT) - \$51.00: is an *on-demand* test that measures your reading comprehension in a particular language. The test consists of a series of written texts and multiple-choice questions. It is taken *online* and lasts approximately **50-125 minutes**.

Credits Awarded: A student can receive between 3-12 credits. Please see the equivalency guide for exact details depending on the skill level assessed.

Eligibility: A student must not exceed the maximum number of transfer credits (90). A student must also not have taken the same language-based exam previously and awarded credits (CLEP, AP, NYU, etc.) The student also cannot be awarded credits if they have already received credits for the courses being awarded either from transfer credits or taken the course(s) at NJCU.
