As its advancement and prevalence increases, educators and commercial workers must ask: how might AI be necessary and beneficial in my field? This week on “Connecting Bridges and Borders,” Professor David Weiss discusses the importance of Artificial Intelligence with Arun Shroff, Founder and CEO of Xtend.AI and Director of MEDIndia's technology, digital strategy, and growth.
