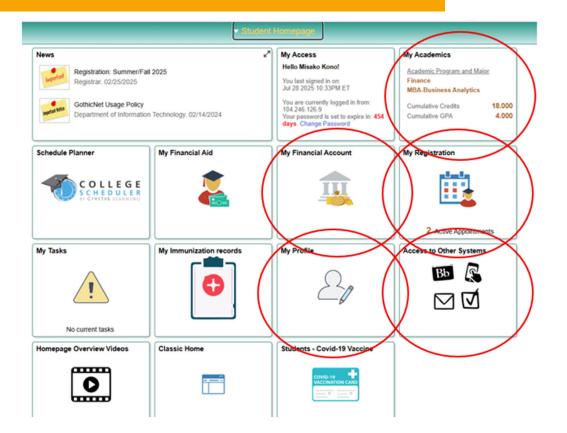

- View your grades and GPA







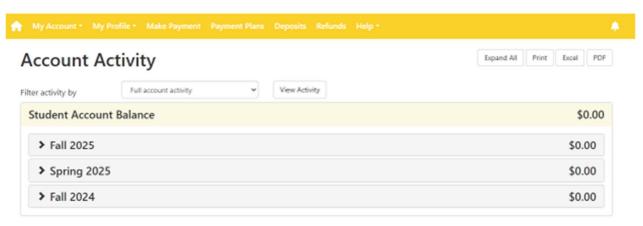


My Financial Account: In this section, you can review your tuition bill and payments.





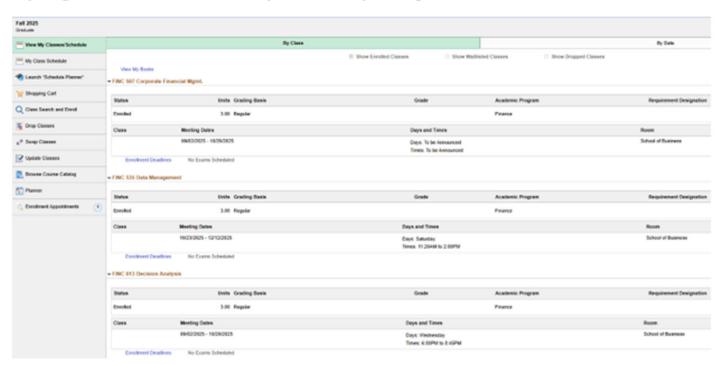

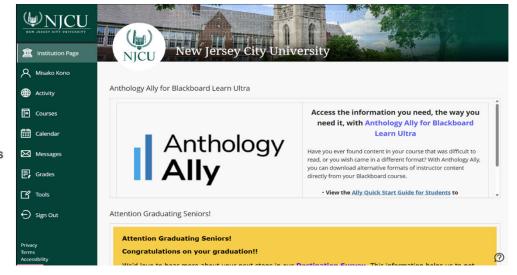


Blackboard is where all your courses are managed. You'll use Blackboard to:

- · Check the announcements from your professors

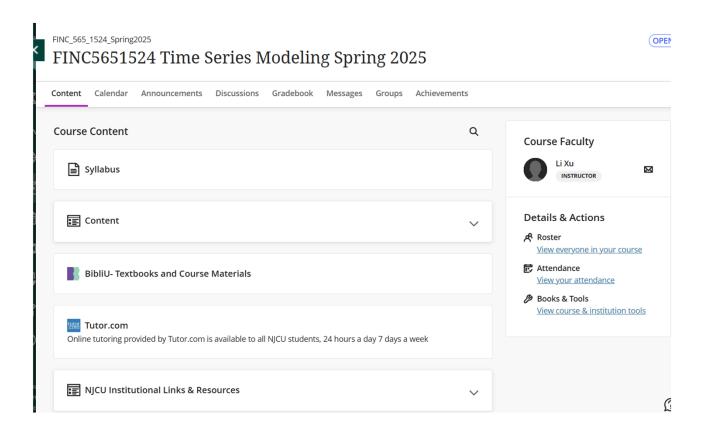
On the left-hand menu, you'll see these key sections:
