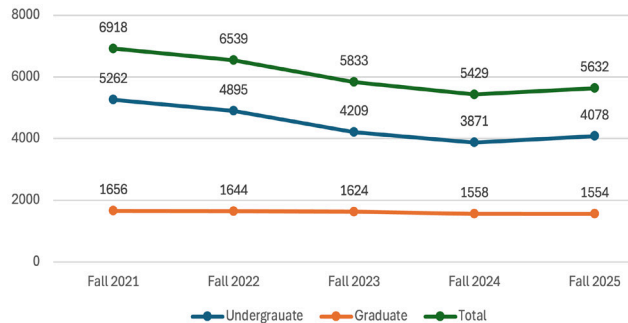


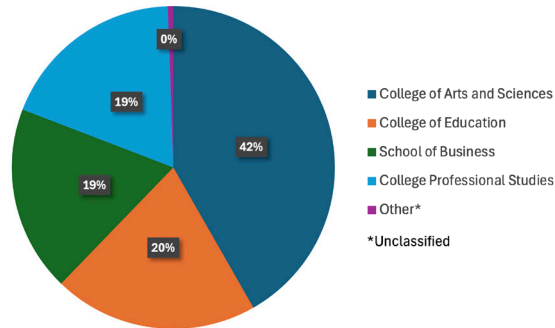

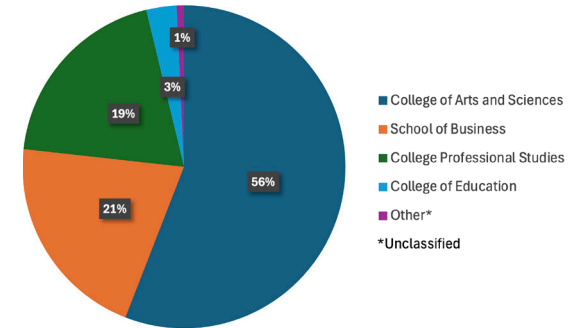
ENROLLMENT TRENDS: 2021-2025

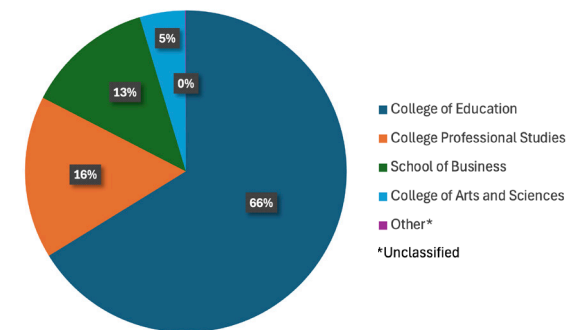

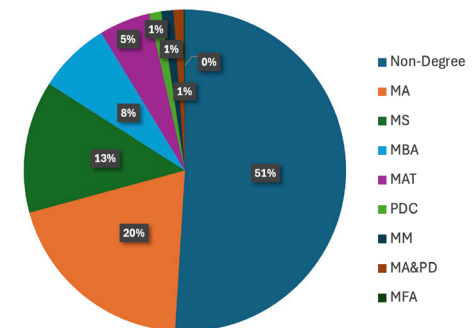

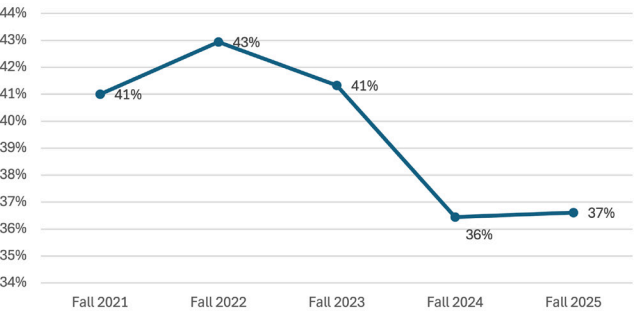

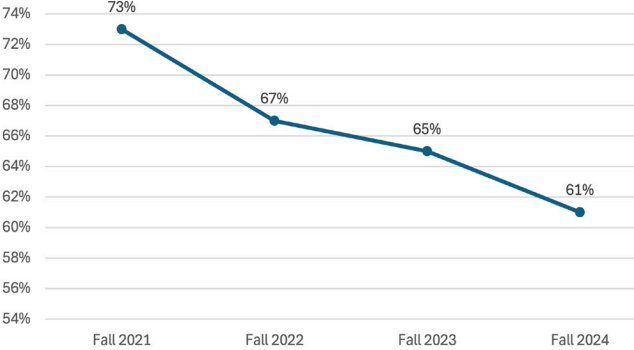
