



## 2021 SUMMER PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENT CHECKLIST

## To be considered for the 2021 OSP/EOF Summer Academy, applicants must:

Complete the <u>Preliminary Screening Survey</u> .
File the 2021-2022 FAFSA or NJ Alternative Financial Aid Application
Submit a completed and signed <u>2021-2022 Verification Worksheet</u>
Submit the following documents via Mapping Xpress. Instructions will be sent to eligible applicants.

- o 2018 & 2019 IRS Tax Transcripts
  - If your parents filed separately but are still married, the filing status for 2019 must indicate "Married Filing Separately."
  - If your parent(s)/guardian(s) own a home, you must provide:
    - A 2018 & 2019 "Mortgage Bank Loan Statement" (showing the Principal Balance Owed on the house)
    - o A 2018 & 2019 "Tax Assessment Statement" (from your local City Hall)
- o Copy of Student's Social Security Card
- o Proof of non-taxable income (if applicable)
  - Social Security Benefits (SSDI/SSI)- Submit a 1099 Form or letter from the Social Security Administration stating the **total dollar amount** received in 2018 and 2019.
  - Welfare Benefits- Submit a letter from Welfare Services stating the **total dollar amount** received in welfare benefits for the year 2018 and 2019.
  - Child Support- Submit a letter from the Court stating the <u>total</u> dollar amount received in child support for the year 2018 and 2019.
- o Proof of Citizenship or eligible non-citizen status (except NJ Alternate Financial Aid applicants)
  - If you are a citizen of the United States, submit one of the following documents:
    - o US Birth Certificate
    - US Passport
    - Certificate of Naturalization
  - If you are an eligible non-citizen, submit one of the following documents:
    - o Alien Registration Card (Green Card)
    - o I-94 Departure Document
    - o Passport with (INS) stamp
    - o Asylum/Refugee Document
