Visa Type	
Visa Requirements	Foreign students seeking to study in Korea should have a Student Visa(D-2) which can be obtained in the nearest Korean Embassy or Consulate. All foreigners, who wish to stay in Korea more than 90 days, should register and issue a "Residence Card" at the Immigration Office in Korea.

Insurance	
Insurance	Health Insurance is mandatory for all international students. Therefore, all students are required to purchase a designated insurance (private health insurance) upon arrival at Inha University. ✗ Even if you already have health insurance at your home university, you MUST purchase a designated private health insurance at Inha university according to government regulations. On-Campus Dormitory	Dormitory fees (as of Fall 2025): approx. USD 950-1000 per semester (including a meal per day) Condition: quadruple rooms Payment can be made in cash upon arrival. ✗ A penalty of KRW 100,000 will be imposed if cancelled within 30 days of check-in. ✗ Dormitory fees will be subject to change each semester. ✗ You cannot check in without a copy of Tuberculosis test. https://dormeng.inha.ac.kr/dormeng/index.do
Off-Campus Housing Introduced by INHA	Off-Campus Housing fees (as of Fall 2025): Around USD 550-600 per month ✗ A penalty of KRW 100,000 will be imposed if cancelled within 30 days of check-in. ✗ International Center provides help for students who wish to stay in a studio-type (1-room) accommodation near the school. ✗ International Center cannot introduce off-campus housing other than the type mentioned above. Students willing to find apartments for share need to find on their own upon early arrival. ✗ Off campus housing fees will be subject to change each semester.

Personal illness and medicines	It's students' own responsibility to take care of personal illness. If students need to bring medicines from their home country to Korea, students need to search whether they are permitted in Korea or not by Korean Ministry of Food and Drug Safety (https://www.mfds.go.kr/eng/index.do). If necessary, students have to take the procedure of requesting the permission of carrying them in advance according to Korean Ministry of Food and Drug Safety.
