

  - 5. Physical—Having good health and energy




### **GALLUP PURDUE STUDY**

- My professor made me excited about learning 63%
- My professor cared about me as a person 27%
- A mentor encouraged me to pursue my goals 22%
- A project that took a semester to complete 32%
- An internship that applied classroom learning 29%
- Active in extracurricular activities
- Percentage that experienced all six factors 3%






# RETENTION AND GRADUATION: THE MURKY MIDDLE

- We will increase the number of professional advisors on campus over the next 6-12 months








