

# **ACCELERATED BSN PROGRAM**

The Accelerated BSN is a full-time,
12-month, 64-credit program for
individuals who hold a bachelor's degree
in any field and have completed the
prerequisite courses. The program is very
competitive, accepting roughly 70-80
students per year. Currently, there is one
cohort offered per year for the program.
Upon successful completion of the
program, graduates will receive a
Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN)
degree and will be eligible to sit for
the Registered Nurse Licensing exam
(NCLEX-RN).



#### TAKE ADVANTAGE OF OUR ONLINE PROGRAMS!

The Nursing Department offers two, fully-online asychronous programs. Course work is self-paced and offered throughout the year, with rolling admission to keep the working nurse in mind.

# **SCHOOL NURSE (CERT & M.S.)**

Students who apply for the Graduate school nurse certificate program can select either the non-instructional or instructional certificate option.

Courses taken in the certificate track allow for continuation into the Master of Science in Nursing with a Specialization in School Nursing.

#### **RN-BSN PROGRAM**

Students who have earned an Associate's Degree, Diploma in Nursing, or a foreign equivalent, can earn a BSN in as little as 12-16 months!

Students can also enroll prior to licensure; New Jersey R.N. license required for degree completion.

#### **NURSING HONORS SOCIETY**

Our Nursing department hosts the Kappa Eta Chapter of the Sigma International Nursing Honors Society. Students who are inducted will benefit from a strong network of professional development opportunities, and local, national, and international collaboration.
