
Lapland University of Applied Sciences Presentation



The <u>Management Department</u> hosted a presentation on the enchanting Finnish Lapland, featuring guest speakers Anzelika Krastina and Maria Palokari from Lapland University of Applied Sciences (LAPIN). They highlighted the natural beauty and cultural diversity of Northern Finland's Arctic region, showcasing everything from the traditions of indigenous Sami reindeer herders to the charm of Santa Claus Village. The discussion included insights into business sustainability, an area of focus during <u>Dr. John Donnellan</u>'s 2022 Fulbright Award with LAPIN, which centered on the sustainable development of this unique region.

Additionally, Professor Krastina has shared her expertise in lectures to NJCU students, while Dr. Donnellan recently presented to LAPIN graduate students on October 29, 2024. Ms. Palokari, representing LAPIN's Student Affairs Office, provided information on study abroad opportunities for NJCU students interested in experiencing Lapland firsthand.
