From April 16-18, Giorgi was invited to attend the 2025 United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) Youth Forum at the United Nations (UN) Headquarters in New York. This year's theme: "Youth at the forefront: Leveraging science and social inclusion for sustainable development".

The ECOSOC Youth Forum is organized by the Department of Education and Social Affairs (DESA) in close collaboration with the UN Youth Office, UN Inter-Agency Network on Youth Development (IANYD), the Major Group for Children and Youth, and the International Coordination Meeting of Youth Organization.

In addition to his participation in the ECOSOC Youth Forum, Giorgi has been nominated to join the 10th Session of the UN Multi-stakeholder Forum on Science, Technology and Innovation for the Sustainable Development Goals (STI Forum), which will take place May 7–8, 2025 at the UN Headquarters.
