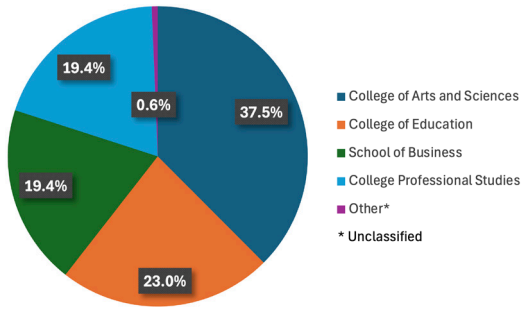

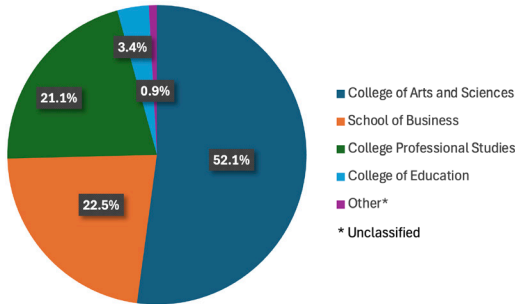

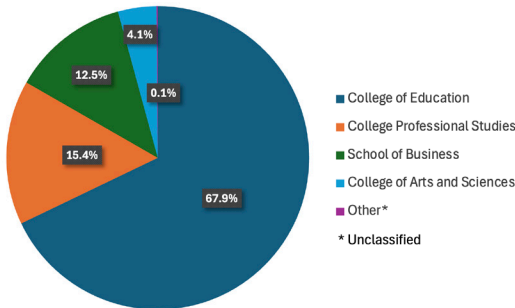
SPRING 2026 ENROLLMENT BY SCHOOL



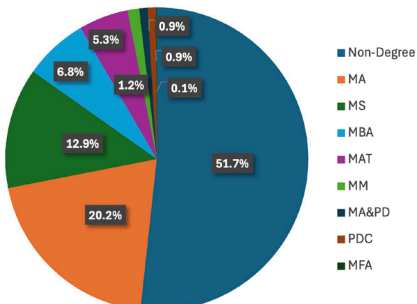
UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT BY SCHOOL

GRADUATE ENROLLMENT BY PROGRAM



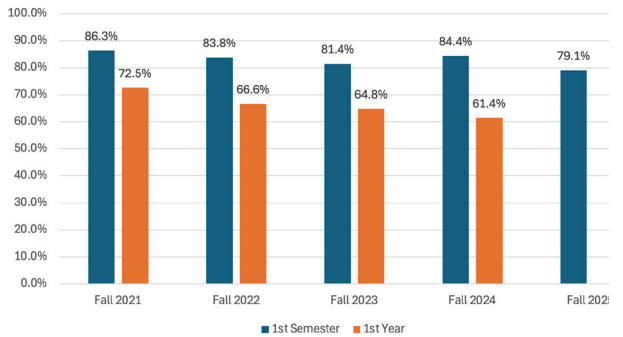

HEADCOUNT BY ACADEMIC LEVEL AND ATTENDANCE

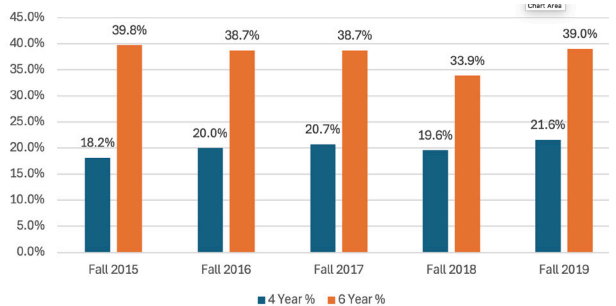
