- Students who worked for pay on-campus or off-campus (CPT or OPT) in the US during 2022
- Students who received scholarship beyond the cost of tuition in 2022







- If you <u>DID NOT WORK</u> for pay in 2022, you and your dependents need to file only Form 8843.

- If you have not received your W-2 Form, contact your employer's Payroll Office.


