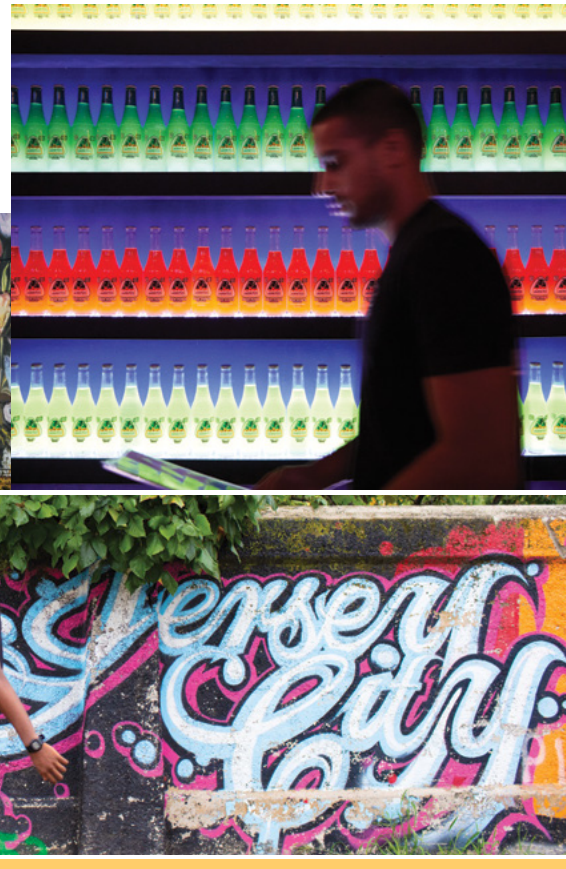

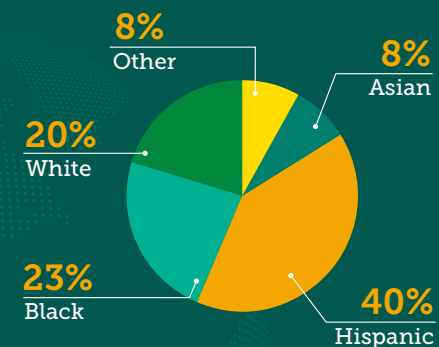


A Global City

Scholarships

NJCU Freshman Scholarships
New Jersey City University's prestigious scholarships are awarded annually to entering first-year students who enroll full-time for the fall semester into an undergraduate program of study. The scholarship review process considers your high school GPA, class rank and the rigor of your academic coursework. **No separate application is required.**

Financial Aid

NJCU is committed to providing students with an affordable education. Our comprehensive needs-based student aid program makes higher education a reality for as many as 80% of our undergraduate population, through grants, loans, work-study opportunities and scholarships.

Debt-Free Promise Program

All New Jersey residents who are admitted to NJCU from high school and attend full-time, with a family household income of \$65,000 or less, will be offered a scholarship through the Debt-Free Promise Program, in lieu of having to take out a loan to cover the cost of tuition and fees (after federal and state financial aid is awarded).

Educational Opportunity Fund (EOF /OSP)

The Opportunity Scholarship Program/Educational Opportunity Fund (OSP/EOF) serves students who come from backgrounds with limited financial resources and academic preparedness in an effort to improve chances for success, ultimately shattering stereotypes that stigmatize these communities. OSP/EOF provides individualized, holistic support services such as personal, academic, career and financial counseling, and tutoring. **No separate application required.**
