- I-20 or DS2019
- A valid passport
- Proof of Payment of SEVIS fee

Pay your visa application fee (as instructed)

- Proof of finances
- Optional: Copy of TOEFL/SAT/academic transcripts (if possible, have your last set of transcripts in a sealed envelope and if you had a transcript/course evaluation done bring copies of that)
- Letter of admission from NJCU (matriculated students only)
