Research Background and Purpose: Changes in the global supply chain continue to accelerate due to shifts in U.S. tariff policies and other factors. Consequently, amid an uncertain geopolitical business environment, multinational manufacturing companies are relocating production bases or diversifying their sources of raw materials. This study examines changes in the global supply chains of major companies worldwide, including those in Korea and the United States. To this end, we aim to analyze the supply chain maps of these companies over time using the <u>Bloomberg Terminal</u>. This research prioritizes automotive and EV battery manufacturers as its primary subjects of analysis.
