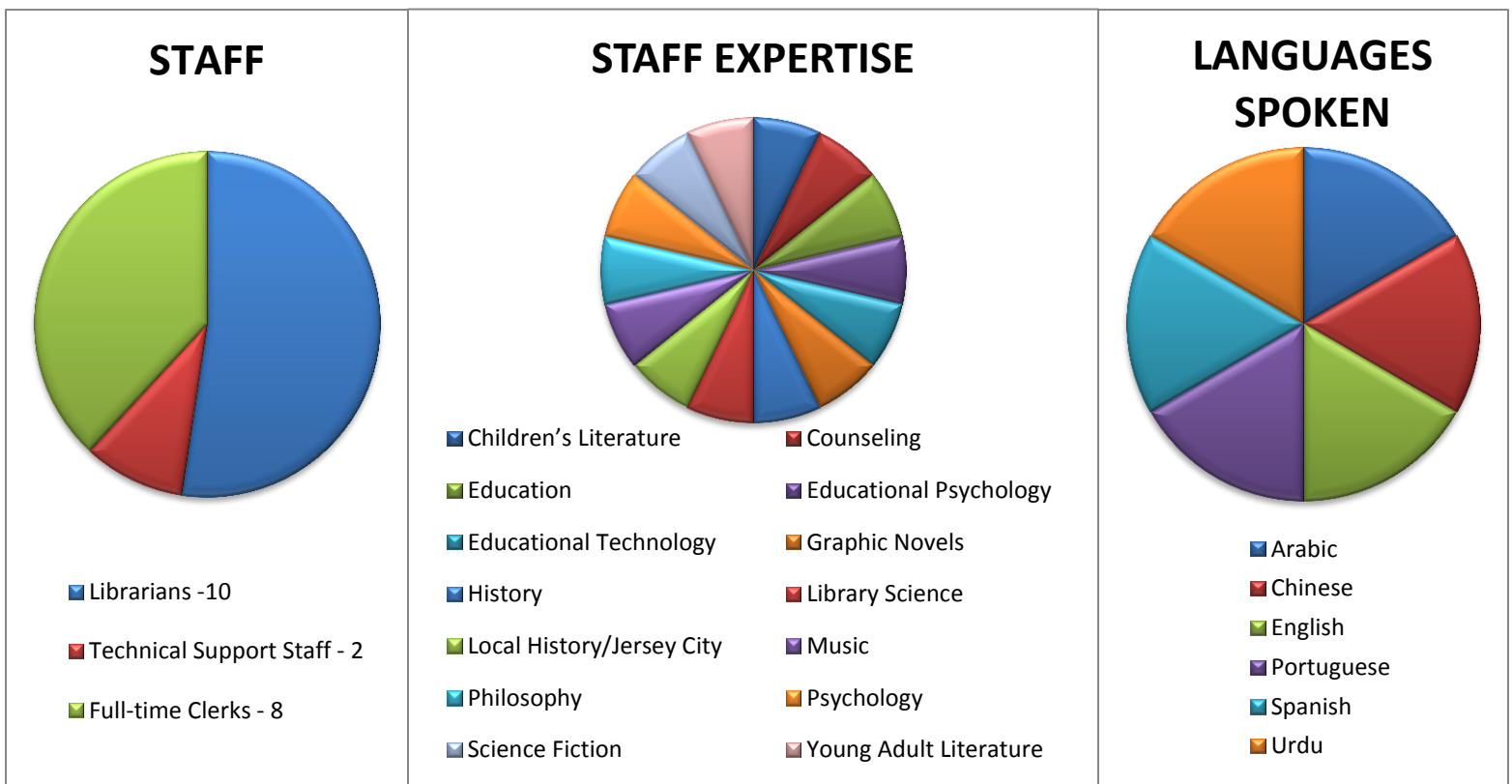


Who We Are; What We Do

The mission of the Congressman Frank J. Guarini Library is to provide service and materials to the students, faculty, staff and community in support of the curriculum and other educational objectives of New Jersey City University, including the learning outcomes for Information Literacy. The library especially supports Goals 1 and 2 of the NJCU Strategic Plan.

The Library reports to the Division of Academic Affairs.



- **Visited** by 231,666 individuals, and 71,601 users looked at 498,000 pages on the Library's homepage
- **Remote Access** – 3,099 unique visitors, 84,000 sessions, 2.3 million page views
- **Taught** 255 bibliographic instruction classes reaching 5,548 students
- **Answered** over 55,000 questions; online tutorial viewed 9,100 times
- **Added** 1,123 volumes to the collection
- **Housed** 300,000 volumes with another 180,000 eBooks available
- **Provided** access to 35,000 periodicals through 152 databases
- **Opened** 81.5 hours per week with extended hours for finals
