GPA Requirements for New Jersey Teacher Candidates

On June 4, 2014, the State Board of Education adopted new regulations for teacher preparation program entry and teacher certification.*

GPA Requirement for Entering a Traditional Route Preparation Program:

If starting coursework in or after fall of 2015: Minimum GPA is 3.0 (with flexibility to 2.75), as long as the cohort average GPA stays above a 3.0, a program has the discretion to accept candidates with GPAs between 2.75 and 3.0

GPA Requirements for a CE or CEAS:

On or after September 1, 2016: Minimum GPA is a 3.0 (with flexibility to 2.75), a candidate may have a GPA between 2.75 and 3.0 if he or she meets one of the following exceptions:

- Graduated prior to Sep. 1, 2016
- If graduated after Sep. 1, 2016, scored at least 10% higher than the passing score on the test of subject knowledge
