THIRD ANNUAL LATI COLLOQUIUM, SPRING 2020

CALL FOR PAPERS

The new Center for Latin American, Caribbean, and Latinx Studies will be hosting the Third Annual LATI Colloquium on **Thursday April 2, 2020** at NJCU's main campus. This Colloquium is designed to be a forum to gather, share, and showcase faculty, student, and alumni research and expertise in topics related to Latin America, the Caribbean, and Latinx Communities in the United States. The LATI 2020 Colloquium will feature paper presentations, posters, and invited speakers.

<u>Paper Presentation</u>: Papers are formal presentations on original research by one or more authors. Each presentation should be 20 minutes, including discussion time. We recommend that you plan 15 minutes for your talk and leave 5 minutes for discussion. The papers should be presented in English.

<u>Posters:</u> The Poster Session is a format for public presentations about projects that use visual evidence. It offers an alternative for presenters eager to share their work through one-on-one discussion, can be especially useful for works in progress, and may be a particularly appropriate format for presentations where visual or material evidence represents a central component of the project.

Submission Process

Write a one-paragraph description of your paper or poster, which should not exceed 150 words (an abstract). Please submit your abstract as an attachment to <u>dblackmore@njcu.edu</u>. The deadline for submission is December 9, 2019. Final decisions will be sent to authors by March 1, 2020. E-mail your questions to <u>dblackmore@njcu.edu</u>.
