Course Level	500 level (undergraduate)
Catalog Description	This course focuses on capstone integration of real organizational situations in the context of global business. Students will evaluate theories of management as applied to business/corporate level strategy, firm performance, and global citizenship in particularly management of multicultural teams, using case studies.
Enrollment and Scheduling	This course will be offered every term. The enrollment cap for this course is suggested at 25.
