



EOF GRADUATE GRANT APPLICATION CHECKLIST

To determine your eligibility for the EOF Graduate Grant, you must complete the items on this checklist by the following deadlines.

September 15th for Fall consideration

January 15th for Spring consideration

- File the 2020-2021 FAFSA or NJ Alternative Financial Aid Application
- Submit the following documents to the Associate Director of the Office of Financial Aid, Mrs. Katrina Smith-Younger at ksmith@njcu.edu.
 - 2017, 2018 and 2019 [IRS Tax Transcripts](#)
 - If you own a home, you must provide:
 - A 2017, 2018 and 2019 “**Mortgage Bank Loan Statement**” (showing the **Principal Balance Owed** on the house).
 - A 2017, 2018 and 2019 “**Tax Assessment Statement**” (from your local City Hall).

OR

- Proof of non-taxable income
 - Social Security Benefits (SSDI/SSI)- Submit a 1099 Form or letter from the Social Security Administration stating the **total dollar amount** received in 2017, 2018 and 2019.
 - Welfare Benefits- Submit a letter from Welfare Services stating the **total dollar amount** received in welfare benefits for 2017, 2018 and 2019.
 - Child Support- Submit a letter from the Court stating the **total dollar amount** received in child support for 2017, 2018 and 2019.

Please note that a final decision regarding eligibility for the EOF graduate grant will be made once the applicant’s registration status is confirmed each semester. Therefore, formal decision notices will be emailed 10 business days after the add/drop period ends.
