

## National Security Studies Spring 2022 Registration Information

Please read through this entire notice. The updated schedule is below for the Spring 2022 term, broken down by site (there are also three summer sessions available). If you are a transfer student there is some important information below. You **MUST** work to register yourself prior to asking for assistance. This way you maintain some control over your process.

**IMPORTANT: Be sure your transfer evaluation says “Associate in Science (or Art) – Blanket Credit”, and if it doesn’t you need to request a final transcript be sent from your community college to NJCU’s Transfer Resource Center ([transferresourcecenter@njcu.edu](mailto:transferresourcecenter@njcu.edu)). Then follow up with them.**

Example of how to ensure you are on track for Transfers. First, print a program planning sheet from [www.njcu.edu/middlesex](http://www.njcu.edu/middlesex) (or if you are from Wall you can go to the NJCU/Wall site or contact Dr. Richard Cosgrove at [rcosgrove@njcu.edu](mailto:rcosgrove@njcu.edu) or Denise Serpico at [dserpico@njcu.edu](mailto:dserpico@njcu.edu)). There shows everything you need from the major. Check off the boxes of what you have taken and what you may need in the way of core courses. Also print the Transferability Information Form that shows the courses you took at MCC (or your other two-year institution) and their equivalents and check them off on the planning sheet as well. See what you need left in cores and you need to get to 120 credits total to graduate.
