

2017 Graduating Student Survey



Overview

In May 2017, a survey was sent to all students who graduated Fall 2016 or Spring 2017, or who were scheduled to graduate in Summer 2017. The survey sought feedback on students' experiences and post-graduation plans

A total of 935 individuals responded to the survey, 723 undergraduates and 212 graduates. Most undergraduates in education also graduated with a content co-major. The distribution of respondents across Colleges is below:

Graduates provided feedback on the extent to which NJCU met expectations in several areas. The percentage of respondents indicating that NJCU met or exceeded their expectations is below:

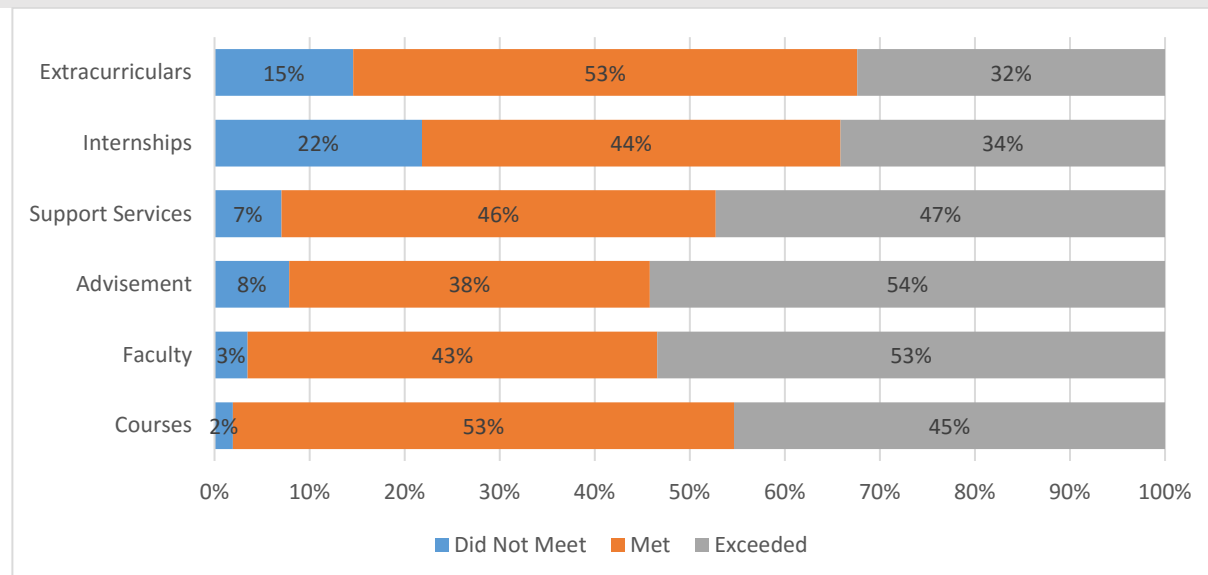

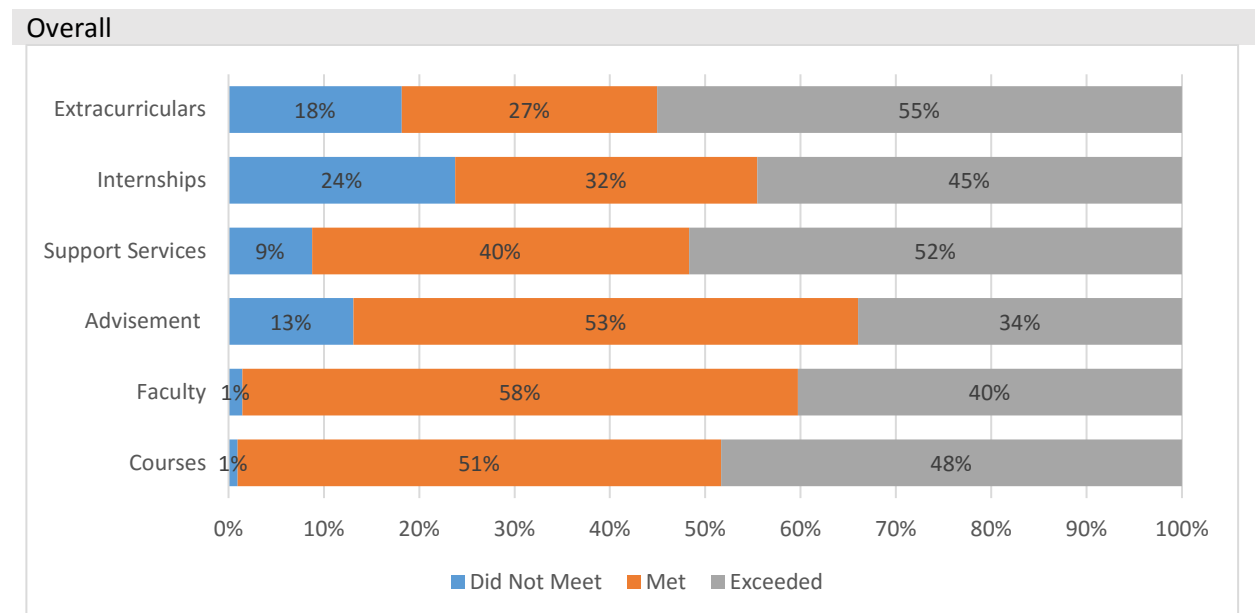

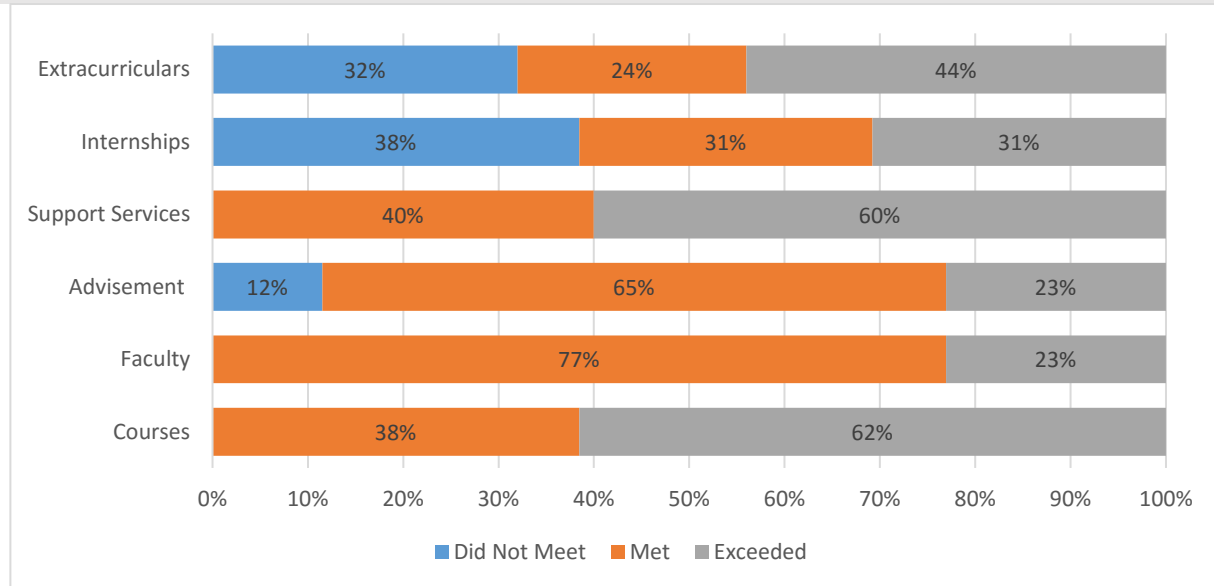
