

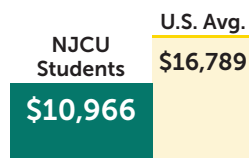
Did You Know?

New Jersey City University is a great investment for students and the community. NJCU continues to have the lowest tuition and fees of all of the public four-year colleges and universities in New Jersey, and 10 years after graduation, students earn 22% more than the national average income. As the chart shows, NJCU students graduate with an average of \$10,966 in debt—35% lower than the national average.

NJCU Students Earn More

Our students earn 22% more than the national average income 10 years after graduation
